KNOWLEDGE OF GOD ISSUES FROM KEEPING HIS COMMANDMENTS

The commandments give rise to the virtues, and the virtues lead to the revelation of the mysteries that are contained and concealed within the words of Holy Scriptures. Let no one be fooled. There is no way of unlocking the trove of knowledge and enjoying the treasures found therein, other than by contemplating and executing the commandments and virtues.

Perfect love for God and man, indifference for all visible things, mortification of the evil deeds and desires of the flesh... and concern only for Christ the Savior's commandments. Furthermore, we are referring to immortality, incorruptibility, eternal glory, everlasting life, the kingdom of heaven, adoption through rebirth by the Holy Spirit, and becoming gods by grace and appointment.
