

THE THEORY OF EVOLUTION IS NOT SCIENCE

The evolutionary model of one cell to man is based on assumptions.

An assumption is something taken for granted and supposed to be true, even though it cannot be proven with scientific experiments.

Evolutionists make several assumptions. They take for granted numerous required processes in the “molecules-to-man” model. In other words, evolutionists assume that non-living chemicals gave rise to the first living cell which, in turn, mindlessly and randomly evolved into ever and ever more complex forms of life. But there are no scientific experiments to prove the “molecules-to-man” scenario. It is not scientifically testable or experimentally verifiable or reproducible or able to be authenticated in any way!

There are seven basic assumptions that are often not mentioned during discussions of evolution. Many evolutionists ignore the first six assumptions and only consider the seventh. The assumptions are:

- 1) that non-living things gave rise to living material, i.e., spontaneous generation
- 2) that spontaneous generation occurred only once
- 3) that viruses bacteria, plants and animals are all related
- 4) that protozoa (single-celled life forms) gave rise to metazoan (multiple-celled life forms)
- 5) that various invertebrate phyla are interrelated
- 6) that the invertebrates gave rise to the vertebrates
- 7) that within the vertebrates the fish gave rise to amphibian, the amphibian to reptiles, and the reptiles to birds and mammals.

These assumptions are the whole of evolutionary teaching. Yet, there is no factual (experimentally testable and reproducible) science that supports evolution! The process of moving from non-living things to the first living, reproducing cell to man and giant redwood trees is all an assumption.

During the eight thousand year old history of man on the earth, no one has ever witnessed a monkey turn into a human being, or chemicals spontaneously coming together to form a living organism.
