Since March of 2024 our eldest son of 2 years started having high fevers every 3-4 weeks. We were told by a rheumatologist that this was caused by an auto-inflammatory disease and that the fevers will probably stop around age 5.

We visited Saint Nektarios Monastery in July 2024 and venerated relics and got blessed by the Saint's cross. After this visit, our son had what seems to have been his last fever caused by the auto-inflammatory disease, which lasted fewer days than usual. Subsequently, the fevers would start, but after a few hours they stopped on their own without us having to give him his medicine.
